Interview with Engr. Gbenga Kuye

E-Newsletter: *Sir, What is the perspective of NEPZA in development regarding industrialization in the future of the country?*

Gbenga: Let me just give you some perspective. When NEPZA was created in 1992, it was created to jumpstart the economy through the introduction of free zone scheme to the economy. Then the focus was largely on export. Now what we have done in the last few years is to look at how NEPZA could key in into the industrialization objective of the government and now we are

transforming NEPZA into Nigeria Industrial Development Sole Authority. The whole idea is that NEPZA will be that agency of government that will be fully responsible for industrialization. We are going to look at how we can attract various sectors of the economy into all our zones. Our zones have now been re-designated as industrial parks and industrial cities in special economic zones. We have commenced a key one in Gas Evolution Industrial Park. The whole idea is to see how we can partner with the engineers in the country and outside to develop our nation ourselves, do technology transfer, create jobs and also help in creating an economy that is totally away from oil.
