Mrs. Essien: No, women can fit into all engineering fields.



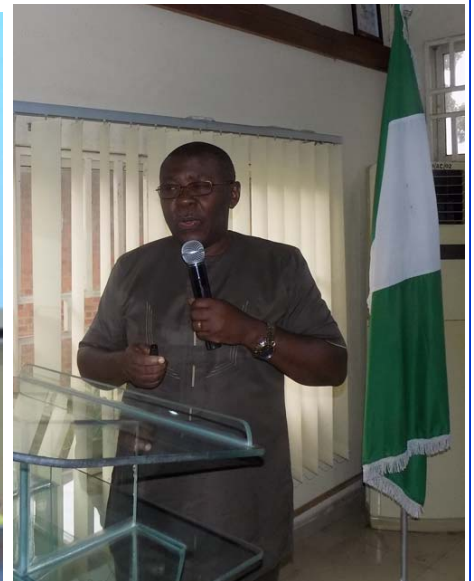
